Row 3: $\leftarrow 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{D}, 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{D}, 1^{*}$
Row 4: $\rightarrow 1^{*}, 4 B, 1^{*}$
Row 5: $\leftarrow 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{D}, 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{D}, 1^{*}$
Row 6: $\rightarrow 1^{*}, 4 \mathrm{~B}, 1^{*}$
Row 7: $\leftarrow 1^{*}, 3 \mathbf{B}, 1^{*}$
Row 8: $\rightarrow 1^{*}, 4 \mathrm{~B}, 1^{*}$
Row 9: $\leftarrow 1 B, 1 A, 1 B, 1 A, 1 B$
Row 10: $\rightarrow$ 6B
Row 11: $\leftarrow 1 \mathbf{C}, 1 \mathbf{B}, 1 \mathbf{D}, 1 \mathbf{B}, 1 \mathbf{C}$
Row 12: $\rightarrow \mathbf{1 B}, 1 \mathbf{1 C}, 2 \mathbf{B}, 1 \mathbf{1 C}, 1 \mathbf{B}$
Row 13: $\leftarrow 5$ B
Row 14: $\rightarrow 1^{*}, 4 B, 1^{*}$
Row 15: $\leftarrow 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{B}, 1^{*}, 1 \mathbf{B}, 1^{*}$
Row 16: $\rightarrow 6^{*}$
